WASHINGTON STATE

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION For Purchase of Alcohol & Tobacco

IDENTIFICATION MUST SHOW:

- Expiration date (except tribal ID)
- Photograph of the bearer
- Date of birth
- Signature (except US Military ID)
- 1. Drivers license, Instruction permit, or ID card issued by any US state or Canadian province or "identicard" issued by the Washington state department of licensing pursuant to RCW 46.20.117.

Note: for Washington State ID's this would include both <u>Regular</u> and <u>Enhanced.</u> To be acceptable, the new <u>Temporary</u> form of ID must be combined with an expired valid ID with a photograph.

- **2. US Armed Forces ID card** (encrypted signature acceptable)
- **3.** Merchant Marine ID card (issued by the US Coast Guard)
- 4. Official Passport (includes the Nexus and the United States of America Passport Cards)
- **5. Washington State Tribal Enrollment Card** (no expiration date required)
